ESTIA presented the TEAMIT+ project at the [second universities forum of the Euroregion Nouvelle-Aquitaine / Euskadi / Navarra](#) which took place in Biarritz on 12th February 2024. This second edition was organized by the Euroregion. The objective of the event was to develop new opportunities for university cooperation within the Euroregion and to encourage the creation of new synergies between its stakeholders. It forms part of the Euroregional University Cooperation Strategy, which is based on areas of action such as the networking of local stakeholders, research and training, and the mobility of students and teaching staff within the Euroregion. The event was attended by 140 participants from universities (98), public institutions (19), higher education organizations (12) and other stakeholders (11).
