### What is TEAMIT+

TEAMIT+ is a European training programme that helps you develop practical skills, build your network, and co-create innovative solutions for sustainable futures. The programme consists of three key modules:

#### Module 1: Understanding The World To Change It

Module 1 gives you the opportunity to participate in **four interactive workshops and role-playing activities**. Explore key topics such as climate change, circular economy, climate justice, and migration, gain practical knowledge, critical thinking skills, and negotiation experience.

#### Module 2: the "24h of Innovation"

Module 2 of the TEAMIT+ training program is an innovation event designed to promote creativity, problem-solving, and teamwork in a fast-paced environment. You will **work in teams created on the spot**, to **develop innovative solutions** - whether conceptual, electronic, or software-based - using a mix of creativity techniques, design thinking tools, and entrepreneurial strategies. It follows a "learning by doing" approach, where teams explore, ideate, prototype, and present their solutions **within a strict 24-hour timeframe**.

#### Module 3: Social4Impact

Module 3 is the final part of the TEAMIT+ programme. **40 participants** (10 from each country) that have already participated in M1 & M2, **are selected**. This module gives them the opportunity to **work in multicultural teams**, developing innovative and sustainable solutions for pressing environmental and social issues. It emphasizes social innovation and team-based entrepreneurship (teampreneurship). The module lasts four months and includes:


- Virtual workshops
