6th Consortium Meeting in Bilbao



On 18-19 March 2026, TEAMIT+ partners met in Bilbao for the 6th Consortium Meeting of the project - two inspiring days of collaboration and reflection focused on shaping the next phase of the programme. Discussions focused on:
