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TEAMIT+ 2nd Bootcamp & Final Event: Celebrating Young Innovators for a Sustainable Future



The second edition of TEAMIT+ officially reached its final milestone in France, bringing together young participants from Spain, France, Finland, and Greece for an intensive journey of innovation, entrepreneurship, and sustainability.

Following the first bootcamp in Athens, participants reunited in Anglet, France, from 6–11 May 2026, for the **2nd Bootcamp** and Final Event. During an intensive week, the international teams further developed their ideas through mentoring sessions, inspirational talks, reflection activities, prototyping, sustainable business model development, and impact measurement.

From water scarcity and food insecurity to circular economy solutions, sustainable agriculture, recycling, energy recovery, healthcare innovation, and waste management, participants transformed ideas into impactful projects through workshops, teamwork, mentoring, and business development activities.

The journey culminated during the **TEAMIT+ Final Event**, where 11 international teams pitched their solutions, exchanged experiences with innovation stakeholders, and explored future entrepreneurship pathways in Europe.

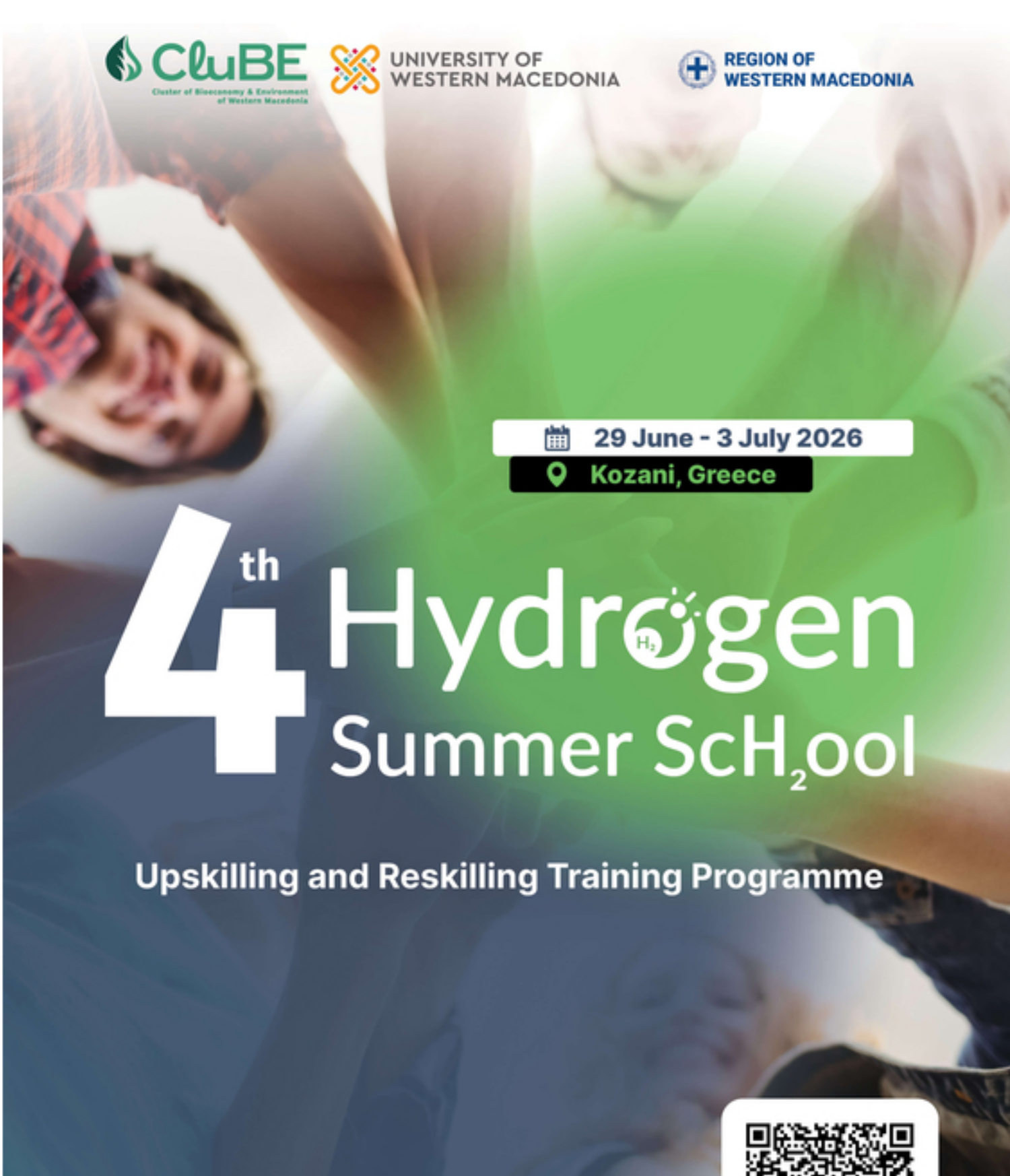

One upcoming opportunity is the [4th Hydrogen Summer School](#). The 4th Hydrogen Summer SchH2ool will take place from 29th June to 3rd July 2026, at the University of Western Macedonia (ZEP Campus, Kozani, Greece).

This initiative is implemented within the framework of [H2VE - Hydrogen Valley Vocational Excellence Hub](#) project, funded by ERASMUS+ programme in collaboration with [Green Skills for Hydrogen](#) project. The programme is organized by the Cluster of Bioeconomy and Environment of Western Macedonia ([CluBE](#)), the University of Western Macedonia ([UoWM](#)), with the support of the Region of Western Macedonia.

This year's edition focuses on the practical application of hydrogen technologies and their role in the development of Hydrogen Valleys. TEAMIT+ research contributes to a new collective work on cooperative law

On 24 June 2026, the [Universidad Pública de Navarra \(UPNA\)](#) will host the presentation of [Cooperativismo y Ordenamiento Complejo: La Norma como Acción de Fomento del Cooperativismo](#), (Cooperatives and Complex Ordering: The Norm as a Means of Promoting the Cooperative Movement) a collective work coordinated by [Rafael Lara González](#) and [Aránzazu Pérez Moriones](#) (UPNA) and published by [Civitas/Thomson Reuters](#).

The TEAMIT+ project is proud to have contributed to this publication. The research carried out provided the empirical and comparative foundation for one of the book's chapters on international cooperatives. The cooperative landscape across the five TEAMIT+ territories (Navarra, Basque Country, Nouvelle-Aquitaine, Central Finland, and Western Macedonia) was mapped, analysing cross-border regulatory challenges for multicultural and virtual cooperatives.

Seeing project outputs feed directly into academic scholarship on cooperative law is a testament to the interdisciplinary reach of TEAMIT+; from green entrepreneurship education in the classroom to shaping the legal and policy debate on the future of cooperatives in Europe.
